What do we document?

We classify each incident according to its content and form.

Content categories include:

- **Racism** towards Black people, Muslim people, Roma and Sinti people, Asian people, people of color and others
- **Anti-Semitism**
- **Hostility against LGBTIQ***, Abbreviation for: Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans, Inter, Queer
- **Hostility against homeless people**
- **Hostility against people with disabilities (Ableism)**
- **Trivialization/glorification of Nazism**
- **Extreme Rightwing Activities**, Ex: advertising or campaigning for extreme right groups
- **Hostility against political opponents of the extreme right**
- **Anti-feminism (as a political strategy)**

Types of incidents:

- **Threats, insults and vulgarities**
- **Attacks**, Ex: physical attacks, arson
- **Structural Discrimination**, Ex: discrimination by authorities, institutions or racial profiling
- **Propaganda**, Ex: stickers and graffiti
- **Events**, Ex: demonstrations, information tables, gatherings
- **Damage to property**, Ex: memorial plaques, brass plates in the street commemorating victims of the German Nazi genocide
- **Bezirksverordnetenversammlungen (BVV)**, Ex: discriminatory motions and speeches in the Berliner district assemblies
- **Miscellaneous**
